The event usually begins at 7:00 a.m. when units, at their pre-assigned areas of the cemetery, place U.S. Gravesite Flags at each grave to recognize and honor our military men and women. Scouts and their families are invited to enjoy refreshments behind the administration building once they are done placing flags. Units must return the following Saturday, May 31, at 7:00 a.m. to remove the flags and place them in bundles for storage for the following year. Rain date is Saturday, June 7, 2008
